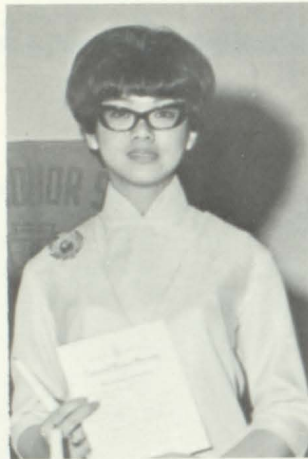


# Centralia's First AFS Student
