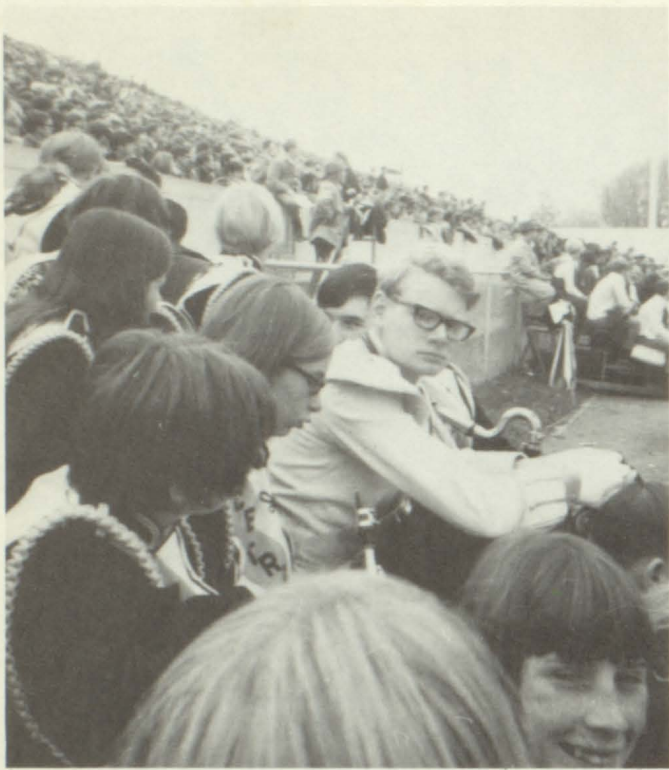
In Appreciation

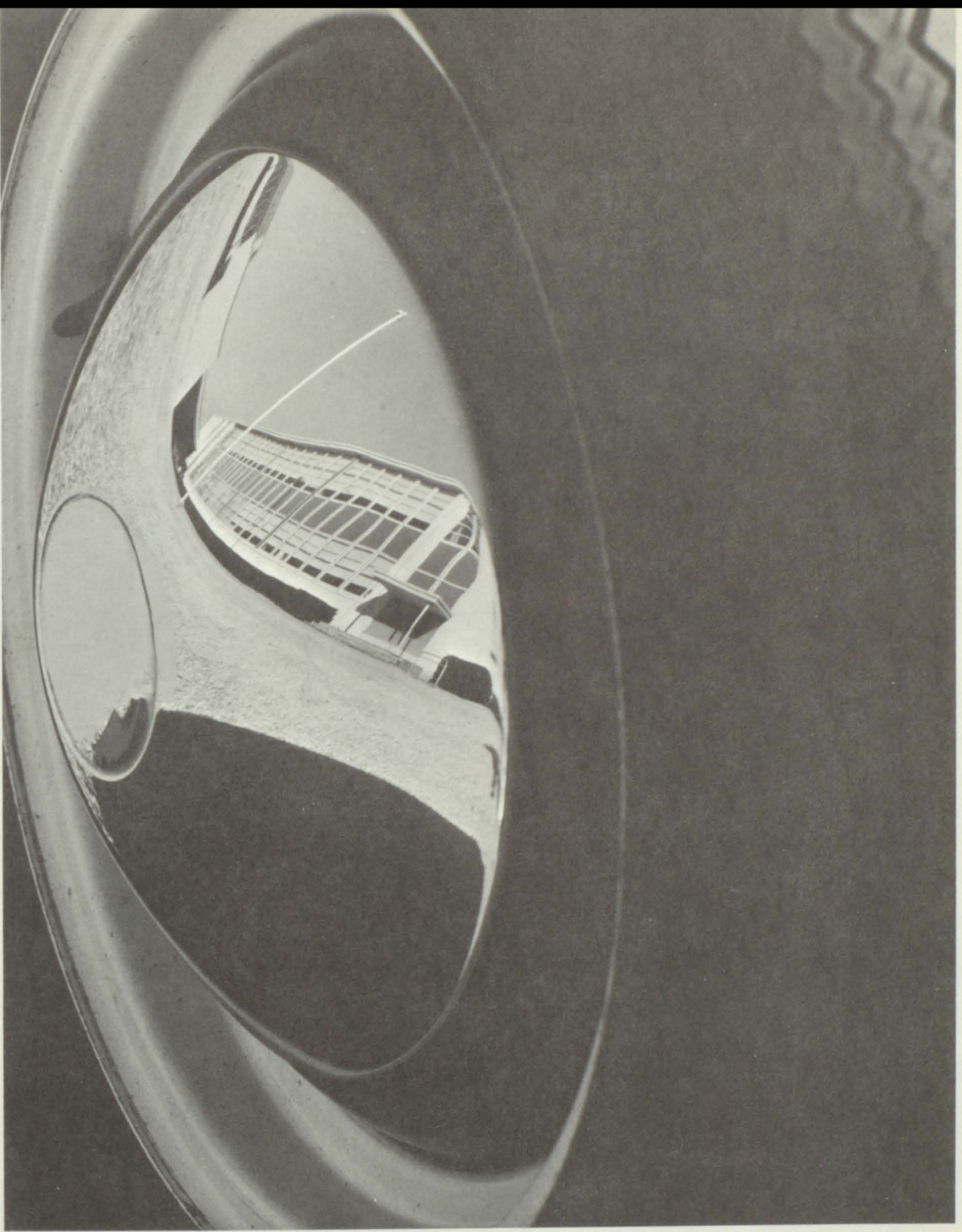
Dedication

FOREWORD

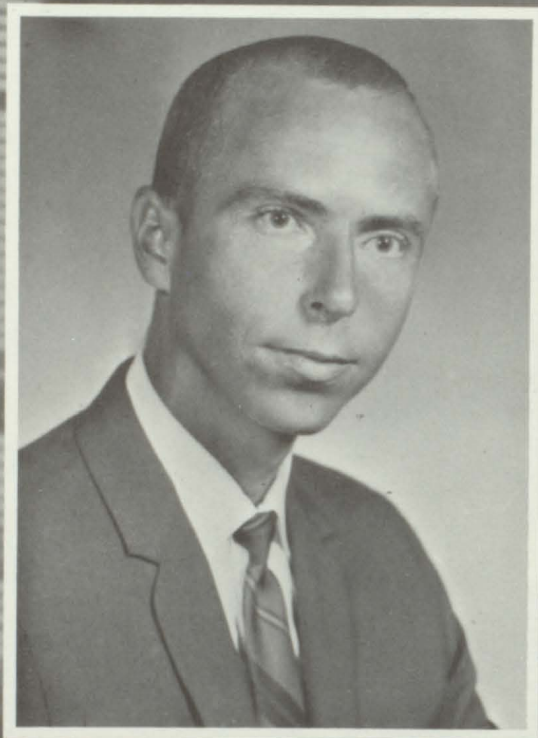

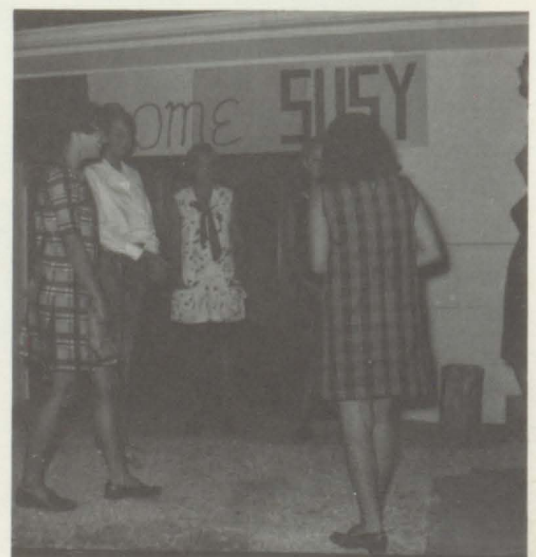

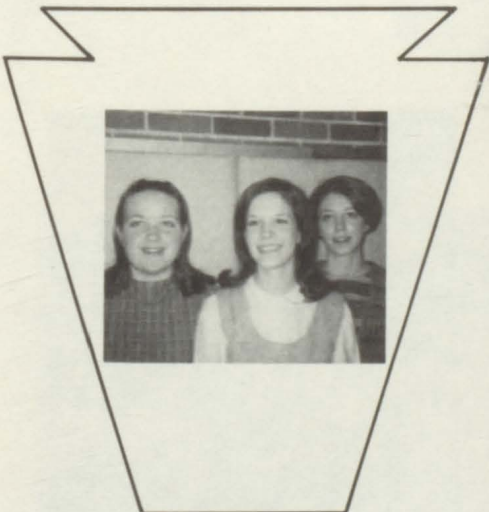

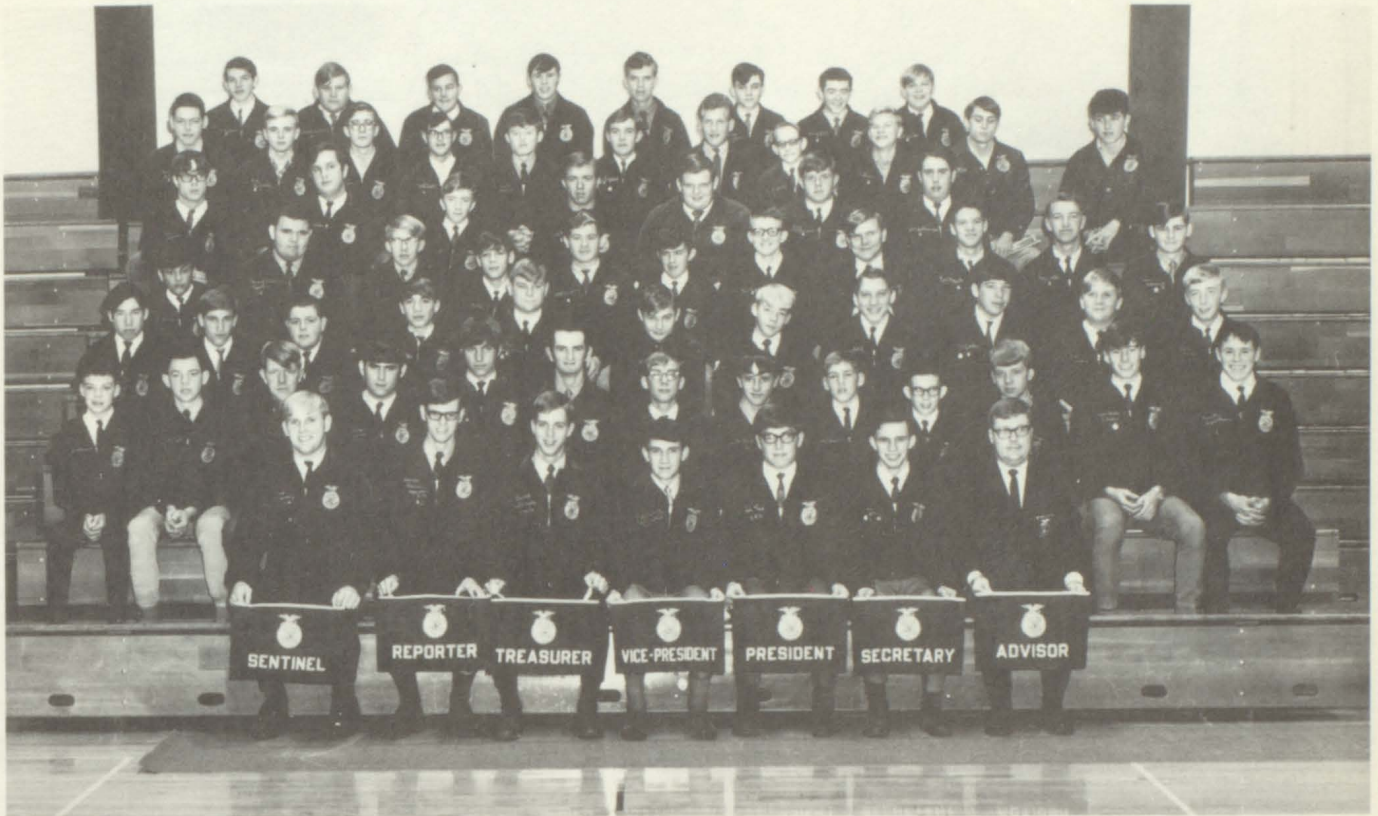

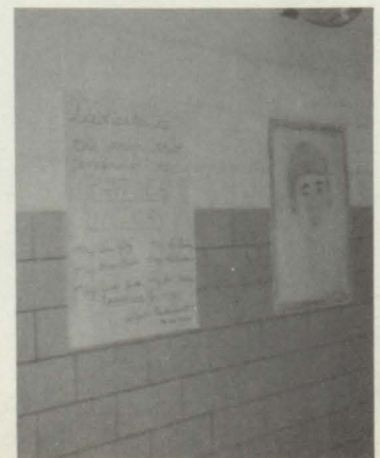
