B. B. HIGHLIGHTS 1974-75

The Panthers placed third in the Centralia tourney and second at the Paris tourney. The end of the regular season found the Panthers tied for third with Mark Twain in the C.C.C.

The Panthers entered the regional tourney unseeded to meet the #4 seeded Van-Far Indians. Van-Far went down to defeat 78-71 in overtime. Following the final game #1 seeded North Callaway fell to the Panthers 59-58. Centralia went on to win the first regional championship since 1931 with a 69-52 victory over Mark Twain.

In a first round state game played at Hannibal, the Panthers defeated South Shelby 74-71.

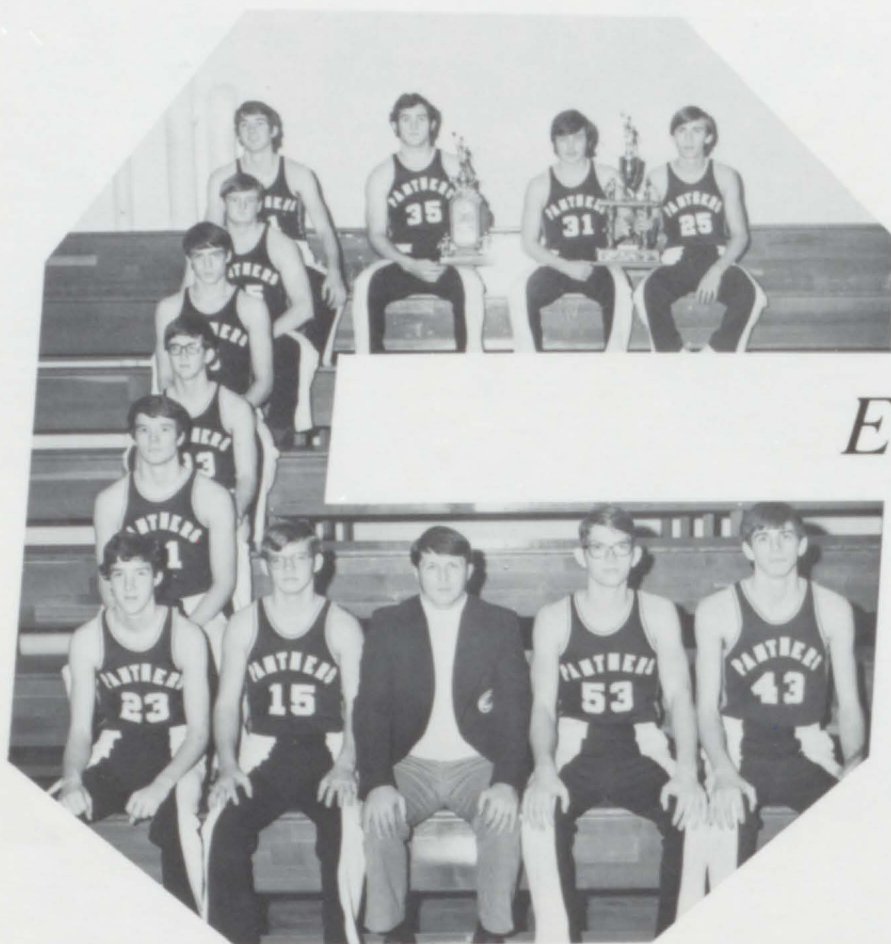
The Panthers lost a hard-fought state quarter final game 64-62 to St. James.
