TAXES UP? TAXES DOWN?

We've been spending a lot of time in Jefferson City lately working with the Missouri legislature on tax bills that help hold the line or actually reduce your taxes.

Here's what we mean:

The legislature has passed and sent to the Governor a bill that would exempt farmers from having to pay city sales tax on farm machinery purchases within a city. If signed by the Governor, this important bill will become law on October 13, 1976.

MFA has also supported action which would prevent the lowering of requirements for passage of general obligation bonds from a two-thirds majority to a simple majority. MFA feels lowering the passage requirements would not be in the best interests of Midcontinent farm families.

In addition, MFA has supported the so-called "Open Window" bill. This simply means taxpayers must be given a preview of local governmental budgeting and tax setting practices by requiring local governments to give notice and hold a hearing before setting tax rates. The legislature has passed this bill and presented it to the Governor for approval.
